Scope

MCC seeks experts with expertise in the following areas: rural and urban land tenure, land administration, land access, gender and land, cadastre/geodesy, property registration, géomètre and/or cartographe with knowledge of technical surveying and mapping equipment, material and software (including CORS stations, GPS equipment, aerial and satellite imagery, and GIS software) and related legal and policy reform.

Tasks

The consultant's assignments may include the following:

- Review and comment on concept proposals
- Assist with designing and implementation strategy reviews
- Provide specific financial and economic analysis of proposed or approved activities and/or other special sectoral or issue-based studies
- Provide oversight of projects and risk management
- Review and comment on ad hoc documents related to Land Tenure

Period and Place of Performance

This consultancy maybe filled as a short or long term consultancy with a base period of twelve months with up to four twelve month option years.

The consultant will work from its home office and/or MCC headquarters or any MCC eligible country.

Subcontracting

The consultant is authorized to subcontract data collection, data preparation, economic analysis, and related services as needed. The overall costs for subcontracting shall not exceed 25% of the consultant's total negotiated unloaded direct labor cost.

Evaluation Criteria

- Knowledge and technical capability in land tenure and property rights related fields
- Knowledge and/or experience as a “géomètre” and/or “cartographe”
- Past experience in developing countries
- Fluent in English, with command of other languages spoken by MCA-eligible countries is highly desirable
- Excellent written and oral communications skills

Other requirements:

International travel may be required. The Consultant may be requested to mobilize on a short notice and will be expected to deliver high quality finished products in a timely manner.
