

# Indonesia Program Summary

Indonesia’s program is helping to reduce corruption in the judiciary, providing support for the Anti-Corruption Commission, enhancing the performance of the Financial Transaction Reports and Analysis Center, and developing pilot e-procurement systems in five provinces. The program is also helping Indonesia build a robust and sustainable immunization system in difficult to reach areas.

## *Program Highlights*

- ★ The majority of the anti-corruption activities ended in April 2009. The remaining communication activity for the Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK) will continue until 2010. Over two thousand judges were trained on the new Supreme Court’s Judicial Code of Conduct, exceeding the program target.
- ★ With MCC Threshold Program support, a total of 10,000 Supreme Court decisions were published on their website. The website is receiving over 22,000 visitors per month from academics, legal practitioners, media and the public per an on-line survey. A database with complete asset management data was handed over to the Supreme Court in March. The total inventory consisted of approximately 1 million separate items. A new public information desk and public complaint desk in the Supreme Court in Jakarta were opened and operational at the end of March 2009.
- ★ All five MCC-supported electronic government procurement centers are now operational with an aggregate budget savings of 15.21% to-date.
- ★ 37 mayoral decrees have been signed in North Sumatra in support of local routine immunization activities thus increasing the likelihood of sustainability of the Threshold Program activities. Over one thousand community-based nurse midwives were trained in basic immunization services and 363 community health center staff were trained on cold chain and vaccine management.
- ★ Nearly 100% of the health centers in Threshold Program targeted districts are using Local Area Monitoring for improved immunization coverage. 98% of the 5.1 million children targeted under one year of age were immunized with measles and DPT3 vaccines in Threshold Program provinces.
